Forgotten P.E. kits and reading books

It has come to my attention that quite a number of parents or carers are dropping off items at the school office (for Ms. Campbell to deliver) that they or their child have forgotten to get ready for school.

Although we will make an exception for a packed lunch that has been forgotten, we cannot accept forgotten items such as reading books, P.E. kit etc. There are few reasons for this:

- Ms. Campbell is very busy and does not have the time to deliver an average of 6 forgotten items per day
- Ms. Campbell is responsible for answering the telephone all day and it reflects badly on our school if, during working hours, people have to leave a message on the answering machine
- We encourage children to prepare, **the night before**, what they need for school the next day. This teaches them good life skills and we ask parents to support us with this

Thank-you for your co-operation and understanding in this matter. I have asked Ms. Campbell, from Monday, to let anyone delivering forgotten items know that she will not be able to deliver them to classes. We will make an exception for the occasional forgotten packed lunch. Please do not let Ms. Campbell feel that you are angry with her if she tells you she can't deliver anything you have forgotten to organise with your child - **if you have a query or concern about this matter, please contact me at your earliest convenience.**
