The carefully structured and witty script helps the audience to understand the difference between **bullying and falling out** and explores key questions, such as. **What is bullying? Why do people bully?** and **What can be done about bullying.** **THE B WORD** also explores **cyber bullying** and looks at the concept of being brave and the importance of telling.
