All users of the school park are reminded of the rules for use of our car park area



1. **Entrance and exit to the car park** - we ask you to remember that we have **clear signs** on the school gates to show which way is the **ENTRANCE** and **EXIT** to school. Several parents / carers are choosing to ignore the one-way system which was introduced to keep children and all adults safe.
2. It is not permitted for people to **park (or pull up) their car on kerbs or pathways.**
3. Car drivers are not allowed to obstruct drivers wishing to safely exit or enter a parking bay. (Obstruction is also caused by parking on a kerb).
4. The **disabled parking bay** is for use by disabled drivers only.

Please note that we will start to take number plates of people who choose to ignore any of these rules: we will issue a warning to that person and if the rules are ignored again, we will ban that person from using our car parking facilities.

There are ample car parking bays which can be used safely.
