Our Poppy Memorial.

This poppy memorial was produced mainly by Mr. Bell, with the support of some staff and pupils. The poppy parts were produced by the staff and pupils over a few weeks. The names and details were researched, and applied by hand to each relevant part of the poppy. The centre button will bear the legend, "We will remember them".

The red parts of the poppy have the name, rank and regiment of teachers from this region who died during WW1.

The green leaves represent hope coming out of the despair; and have on them the name, rank and military award given to teachers from this region who survived the war and returned home.

The white tiles have the names of service personnel from this region who were POWs during WW1; the name of the camp where they were held, are below the names.
