Parking on Cardigan Road

I have been contacted by several residents in Cardigan Road who are very upset by the parking by some of the parents / carers of pupils of our school. They tell me that drives are being blocked, obstructions are being caused, and zig-zagged areas being parked on. They tell me they are upset by the lack of consideration for residents and also the danger this is causing to pupils and other members of the public.

On behalf of the residents, all staff and pupils I therefore ask all parents/carers to park respectfully when dropping children off or collecting them from school. I have taken advice from Sunderland City Council who aim to work in partnership with the police to identify cars and owners who are parking in this way. I therefore ask you all to be alert and if you see someone parking irresponsibly please speak with them, or inform me.

The council representative has asked me to ask residents to inform the police if anyone blocks their drive or causes an obstruction. I have passed this information on.
