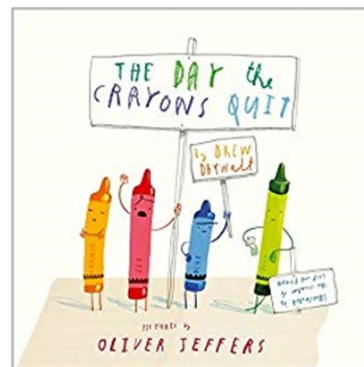
Year 5 Trip
