Athletics

Well done to our Year 3/4 pupils who took part in the Quad Kids Athletics tournament on Tuesday afternoon. The pupils took part in 60m sprint, 400m, long jump and howler throw events; with some pupils winning in their races and every pupil putting 100% in to each event. The school finished in 5th place out of 13 schools.



On Thursday afternoon it was the Year 5/6 pupils turn to represent the school in the Quad Kids Athletics with pupils taking part in 75m Sprint, 600m, long jump and howler throw events. Every pupil gave their all in each event, especially the gruelling 600m run, and this showed with pupils winning in a number of races. Well done to the team!
