Operation Encompass

As you might be aware, we have been involved in 'Operation Encompass' for almost three years now. Through Operation Encompass, key adults in school are sent police information following incidents of domestic abuse, allowing us to give appropriate and timely support to our children.

Northumbria Police have recently been successful in securing additional funding to take part in the Home Office Funded Project – Operation Encompass: The Next Steps. As part of this project, teaching materials will be used to enhance our existing PSHE curriculum to teach children about friendships and relationships, rules and expectations and emotions and empathy, at an age-appropriate level. Our school will also have one of twelve School Safeguarding Liaison Officers (SSLO) who will support staff in the delivery of the above sessions but will also offer drop-in sessions to parents and children to discuss relationships and/or domestic abuse.

The first drop in session will be on Tuesday 25th June between 2.30 and 4pm. If you would like to speak to our SSLO, Alex Hillery, please come to the school office.

Nursery Trip

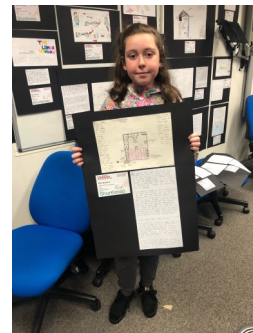
