I wish you all a happy summer holiday and send you all my good wishes for the future.



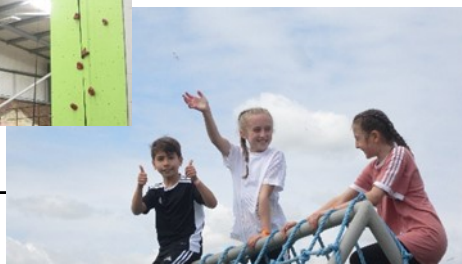
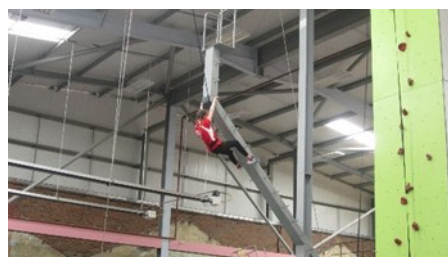
### Breakfast Club
