Thank you to Hylton Castle Mission for being so inviting and welcoming; we appreciate how much time and effort must have gone into this.

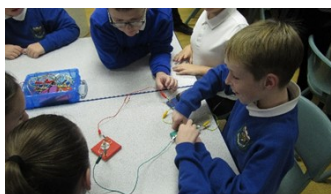
Dog Poo
